Occupational therapists provide services that help restore function, improve mobility, relieve pain, and prevent or limit permanent physical disabilities of patients suffering from injuries or disease. They are required to be able to apply occupational therapy assessment, intervention, and planning, conduct the appropriate documentations and evaluation, and direct occupational Therapist Assistant and/or rehabilitation Technician staff. Therapies may include facilitating the use of the hands and promoting skills for listening, following directions, social play, dressing, or grooming.
